Deeper Faith Summer Series**The Consecration (Week 8 of 8)**

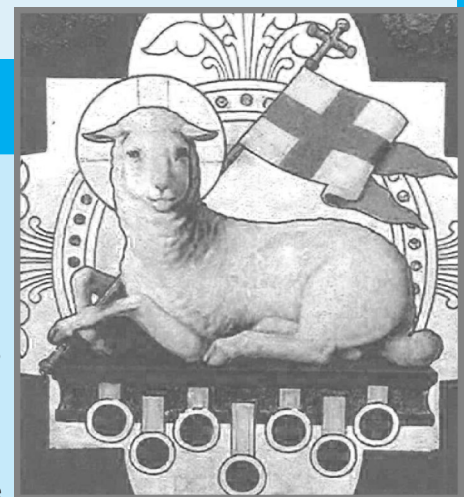
Join us this summer for an eight-week "Deeper Faith Summer Series" with weekly lessons on the Mass.

Continuing our walk through the Mass, this week we focus on the second part of the Eucharistic prayer called the "institution narrative" and consecration. The priest continues the prayer, giving praise and thanks, and calling upon the Holy Spirit to change our gifts of bread and wine (and by extension since they are the work of human hands, presented by us, to change the entire Body of Christ assembled) into the Body and Blood of Christ.

He then recalls the events of the Last Supper—the institution of the Eucharist, by which, by means of the words and actions of Christ, we too participate in that Sacrifice which Christ himself instituted during the Last Supper. It was there he offered his Body and Blood under the species of bread and wine, gave them to the Apostles to eat and drink, and left with them the command to perpetuate this same mystery. And so we are gathered with Him, carrying out that command.

At this important moment in the prayer, we proclaim the mystery of faith (usually sung). Several texts are possible, for example: "We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again." Or "When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again." Or "Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free."

Go to the website to learn more about anamnesis: the priest continuing to recall the wonderful deeds of salvation in Jesus' passion, death and resurrection so that we might encounter them today.
