Prayers for the Victims & Wounded in the Coptic Cathedral Bombing - We invite you to join us as we stand in unity and prayer with our fellow Christians following the Dec. 11th bombing in Cairo. While gathered at the St. Mark's Coptic Orthodox Cathedral, an explosion claimed the lives of dozens of worshippers and injured many more. In his statement, Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo, President of the U.S Conference of Catholic Bishops, reminds us during the Advent season - "even the shadow of violence and terrorism cannot obscure the light of our coming Savior." We pray for His light to shine on our Coptic brothers and sisters and to bring them peace during this time of sorrow.

We ask for God's protection for our fellow Christians in Egypt and for all who have been affected by this act of violence.
