# **Lent 2017: Information and Dates**

### Benediction and Stations of the Cross

6:30 pm Fridays during Lent except on Good Friday

#### **Saturdays of Lent**

Holy Hour and Benediction after Daily Mass

Daily Mass, Monday-Saturday, 8am and Confessions on Saturdays from 4-5pm

**Fasting and Abstaining Rules** 

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is covered by all 14 years of age and older. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Good Friday, April 14, 2017, is a day of fast and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Fasting, almsgiving and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

A gift from St. Bridget: we offer a nursery at no-charge to our young families. Following is part of a series of information about this nursery which can be found in full on the parish website. Regular users are asked to register your child (ren) and sign up to help at one Mass every three months.

**Instead of the nursery** - Some parents with restless children prefer to stay in the care room in the vestibule at the back of the church or in the hallway near the bathrooms and the nursery, since the television in the hallway broadcasts the Mass, as does the television in the nursery. Again we would like to invite you to join us in the nursery during any part of the Mass on any Sunday. If you decide to use the nursery on a regular basis, we will ask you to *register your child and volunteer to help us in the nursery during one Mass every three months*, but please feel free to drop in as often as needed to let your child become comfortable with us before you make that decision. Note that we release the children back only to the person who brought them to the nursery until we get to know who all the family members are!
