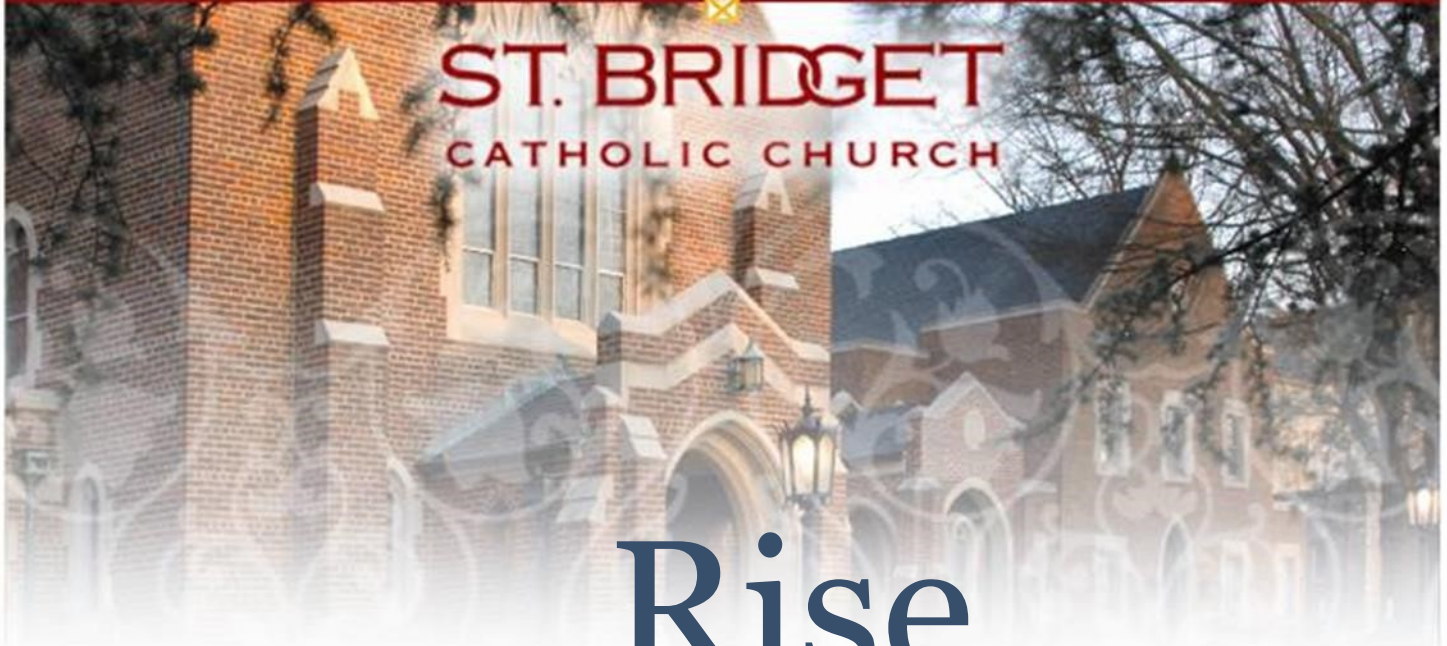

Deeper Faith Summer Series

Giving Thanks in Prayer (Week 6 of 8)

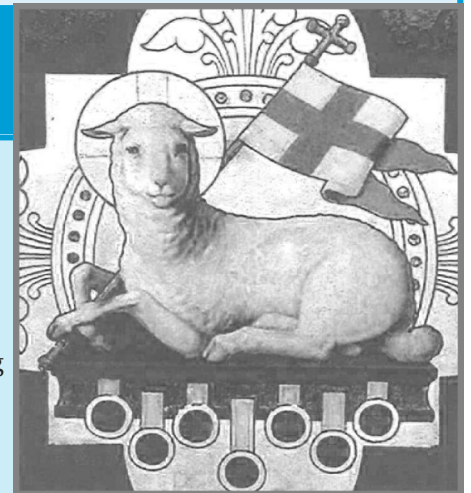
Join us this summer for an eight-week "Deeper Faith Summer Series" with weekly lessons on the Mass.

The introductory dialogue establishes that this prayer, the prayer of the baptized and ordained, is offered in the presence of God, and has thanksgiving as its central focus. Following this dialogue, the celebrant begins the Preface. The ritual dialogue begins with "The Lord be with you" and ends with the people acclaiming that "It is right and just" to give thanks and praise to God. This ritual dialogue that precedes the beginning of the prayer then places us all, assembly and the ordained serving in persona Christi, in right relationship with God by affirming our shared intention to give thanks to the Lord our God.

The Eucharistic Prayers make clear that these prayers are offered, not to Christ, but to the Father. It is worship offered to the Father by Christ as it was at the moment of his passion, death and resurrection, but now it is offered through the priest acting in the person of Christ, and it is offered as well by all of the baptized, who are part of Christ's Body, the Church. This is the action of Christ's Body, the Church at Mass. Note: Many who gather with us each week are not in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. It is good to note however, that this prayer belongs to all the baptized.
