Dear Volunteer:

In recent years, the Catholic Diocese of Richmond has instituted a mandatory screening process for all parish volunteers. This process is designed to protect our children from harmful individuals and to ensure a safe environment from the sexual abuse of minors. I regret that this process is necessary but I know you share our concern for the safety of our children.

Volunteers are to be screened every five years and are required to attend an educational workshop. The Virtus program, "Protecting God's Children", is designed to teach adults how to recognize and respond to child sexual abuse and how to keep our children safe. While screening must take place every five years, you only need to attend the workshop one time.

You are receiving this letter because our records indicate that either you have not been previously screened or that it has been five years since you were last screened. Attached are forms for you to complete as well as instructions for completing the forms. Please return the forms to the parish office as quickly as possible. This website also lists the dates, times and places where the workshop is being offered in the Richmond area. We ask that if you have not attended the workshop, please register as soon as possible.
