

PARISH SURVEY WORK: RESULTS AND RESPONSE

Our Vision- From Rev. Ken Shuping, Pastor

Dear parishioners,

We are eager to support our community in delving deeper into the faith together, as well as fostering your personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Thank you for your patience as we have planned our response to the survey that we took in the fall of 2024. The survey has been a great reminder of our need for one another and the gift and duty of parishes.

Many of you will recall that we produced our own survey in 2022. We completed some response action items that enriched the life of our parish, such as restarting Children's Liturgy of the Word, regularly promoting Sunday adoration to young adults, instituting a Mystagogy session for teens finishing Confirmation prep, and designating liaisons within Parish Council. But we did not craft a follow-up structure for our 40+ goals. This time around, we wanted professional guidance in assessment of the parish and the response plan. The **Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI)** has provided critical support. But we could not have made these strides without you, our parishioners—our response total of 449 families was more than satisfactory!

KEY DRIVERS

What drives parishioners to share their parish and their faith?

Below are questions that CLI marks as strong indicators of parish health. See how the people of Saint Bridget responded.

Leadership Indicators:

39% of respondents strongly agree and **44%** agree that they recommend the parish.

Sunday Experience:

29% of respondents strongly agree and **48%** agree that St. Bridget makes them feel welcomed and accepted

Spiritual Practices:

11% of respondents attend Mass daily and **73%** weekly.

Missionary Impulse:

11% of respondents invited someone to a parish event monthly or weekly.

Our Priorities and SMART Goals

The Catholic Leadership Institute defines priorities as areas of focus born of the patterns in survey results. SMART goals are Specific/Measurable, Motivating, Attainable, Relevant, and Timebound/Trackable. They are not action items or statements of attitude.

PRIORITY 1: ENGAGEMENT

Goal I: Increase the percentage of respondents who strongly agree with the question on the Disciple Maker Index Survey, "My parish helps me connect with a local Catholic community by making me feel welcomed and accepted" from 29% to 45% in a 2027 parish survey by January 31, 2027.

Goal 2: Increase Sunday Mass attendance by 25% from 950 to 1200, by November 2026.

PRIORITY 2: FORMATION

Goal I: Create opportunities for retreats and workshops (speaker with breakout discussion groups) at least monthly, with 100 people attending on average by January 31, 2027.

Goal 2: Increase the percent of respondents who strongly agree with the question on the Disciple Maker Index Survey, "My parish equips me to have conversations about my faith with family and friends by growing my confidence in the Church's teachings so I can answer others' questions" from 12% strongly agree to at least 22% strongly agree, by January 31, 2027.

PRIORITY 3: DISCIPLESHIP

Goal 1: By January 2027, attain 25% of survey responses reporting that at least weekly, "I have spiritually accompanied someone outside of my family by entering into deep discussion about faith."

Goal 2: Create a mentoring program with at least 24 mentors by January 31, 2027.
