We have some amazing activities and projects planned for this year. In order to make camp and all of the activities happen, we need adults to be involved. First and foremost we need adult campers. This is an amazing experience and a lot of fun! You do not have to be particularly handy to go or have special skills. All that is needed is willingness and a good attitude. The bottom line is that we can only take the number of students that we have adults to cover. There is a required 5 to 1 ratio and we strive to have closer to a 4 to 1 ratio in order to meet our Diocese's VIRTUS requirements. If I can't get enough adults, then I will have to take fewer teens and I really don't want to say no to any teen who wants to participate. We also need adults at service projects, the spaghetti dinner and fundraising. You will be amazed at our teens – their spirit, their love and the laughter we all share as a community!
