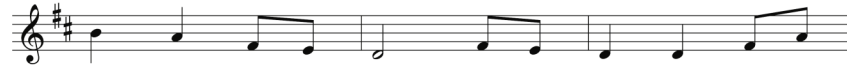



**NICENE CREED**




