**HOMILY**

**NICENE CREED**

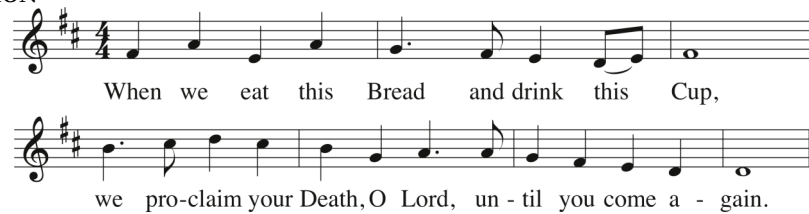

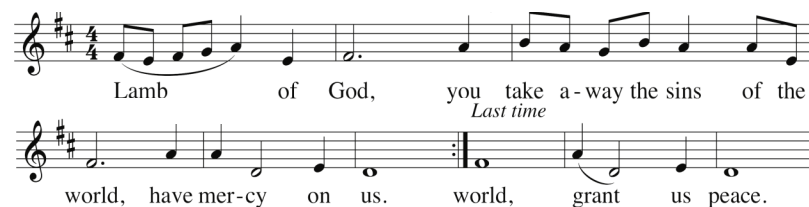

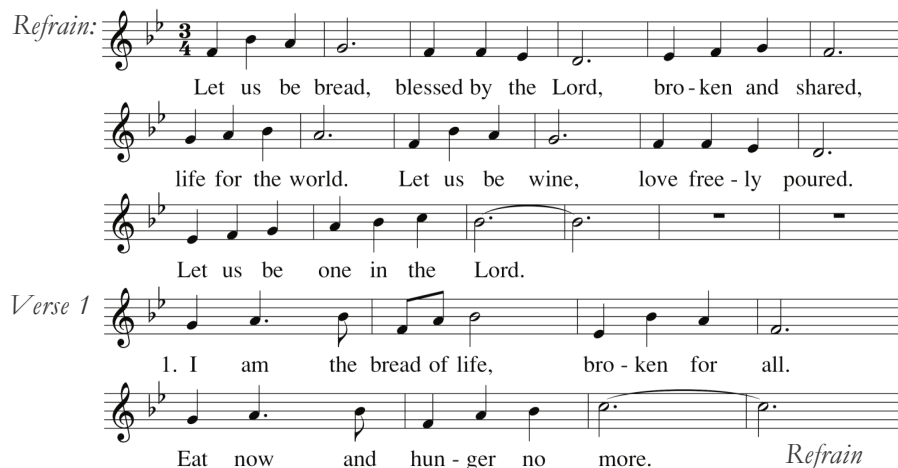
