HOMILY

NICENE CREED


INVITATION TO PRAYER





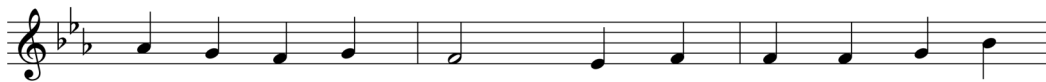
