All: Our Father, who art in heaven, but deliver us from evil.


Priest: Deliver us...the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

INVITATION TO COMMUNION


Priest: Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.
