Expectations for CHWC 2019 Campers -

Time Commitment –

- 1. Sign up for one after Mass slot to help with sales for fundraisers such as: Peanut sales, Spaghetti Dinner ticket sales or Cake Sale
- 2. Sign up to work at the Spaghetti Dinner
- 3. Sign up for one or more service projects
- 4. Plan on attending Adoration and Blessing of the Campers.

Fundraising and Costs -

FINANCES ARE NEVER A REASON FOR A CAMPER NOT TO ATTEND!!! LET ME KNOW IF YOU HAVE ANY ISSUES!

- 1. **Deposit** \$170 Pay when you sign up. This deposit is nonrefundable. We are purchasing a spot for you when you sign up. If you drop out, we are still responsible for the cost of your spot. Spots cost significantly more than the deposit.
- 2. **Peanut Sales** There are 2 parts to the peanut sales.
 - a. Brochure Sales Each student camper sells peanuts. The goal is \$100.
 - b. After Mass Sales Theses are in December and we help out with these by filling the after Mass slots. There is no personal responsibility for selling a certain amount.
- 3. **Cake Sale** Each family will make 2 cakes for the Mother's Day Cake sale. Note: This is 2 cakes per family not 2 cakes per camper.

** You may opt out of either the Peanut Brochure sales or the Cake Sale but not both. Opt out of the peanut sale by adding \$75 to your camper deposit and opt out of the cake sale by adding \$50 to your camper deposit. For the Peanut sale it is \$75 per camper and for the cake sale it is \$50 per family.

4. **Free Day** – Free day is the last day at camp where we don't go to our worksites. It is intended to be a day to spend with your parish. We will not know the cost of this until the winter but it will not exceed \$55 and we try our best to put something together that is reasonable and fun.
