FIRST READING: Exodus 22: 20-26

Thus says the LORD:



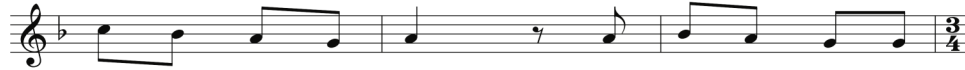
